Discussion	Tracy Johnson called the meeting to order at 9:15 am and called for a vote to approve the October, 2017 meeting minutes. The board approved.
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Principal's Report

Mrs. Diane Cohle

Discussion	Mrs. Cohle presented the Principal's Report.
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Mrs Cohle introduced **Sue Tede**, former Principal at Beaumont Elementary School, and current Chairperson of the T/E elementary school redistricting committee. The committee was formed to re-balance the student population among three schools: Beaumont, Hillside and Devon. The buildings are designed to manage 450-500 students each. Devon's population has swelled to over 600. A professional demographer has been hired by the school board to map the current student population, and from which neighborhoods the boundaries can best be re drawn. Other considerations are the bus routes, contiguous neighborhoods, proximity to the school, and legal restrictions. The demographer's report is available on the T/E web site.

Mrs. Cohle gave her report;

American Education Week: November 13-17. This year, special area classes are highlighted. Will be different for each class. A memo has been sent home with students. Check for your specific class. Lunch is available for any day that week with your student.
